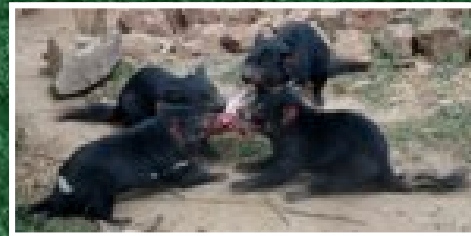


Chudleigh Honey Farm
