Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrive Launceston - lunch en route



Greeted by your guide at the airport and transferred to your accommodation. Depending on arrival time, we may make a stop at the Trowunna Wildlife Park to pat a koala, cuddle a wombat and see the Tasmanian devils being fed. From Trowunna we make our way through rolling countryside to Cradle Mountain. Time permitting a walk before dinner is an option.

Day 2 - Cradle Mountain Activities

Today we take in the alpine wilderness of Cradle Mountain with a hike in the Cradle Valley - Crater Lake Circuit

Walk: 9.4 km

Time required: 5-6 hours

Grade: medium

Environment: Alpine moorland, glacially formed lakes and alpine mountain ascent to craggy exposed dolerite tops.

Available Options: Shorter guided or unguided walks

Day 3 - Depart Cradle - Taste of Tamar Tour & Platypus House

Departing Cradle Mountain we travel to the beautiful Tamar area for a vineyard tour with a difference, Pepper Bush Adventures combines the invigorating and indulgent landscape of Tasmania with a meander through the Tamar Valley and its vineyards, the river reflecting colours or the varying seasons and the wonderful dining experience at Daniel Alps' Strathlynn Restaurant. A visit to Platypus House can be

included today.

Overnight Launceston's Peppers Seaport Hotel - Dinner at Stillwater Restaurant

Day 4 - Depart 8.30 am - Ben Lomond to Freycinet National Park

Today you will experience Tasmania's second highest peak hiking at Mount Ben Lomond and viewing a superb display of alpine flora and vegetation.

Walk: 12.7 km

Time required: 4-6 hours

Grade: medium

Environment: Alpine ascent, exposed alpine meadows

Options: Shorter walks available

From Ben Lomond we travel east visiting the Evercreech Forest Reserve to visit the "White Knights" the tallest white gum trees in the world before finishing our day on the Freycinet Peninsular



Overnight Freycinet Lodge - dinner inclusive

Day 5 - Freycinet National Park Activities- Wineglass Bay-Hazards Beach Hike

Today we embark on an easy circuit walk at Freycinet Peninsula which provides the opportunity for a break at both Wineglass Bay and Hazards Beach with swimming or lazing at either or both beaches.

Walk: 13 km (including 3 km on Wineglass Bay beach)

Time required: 5-6 hours

Grade: Easy

Environment: Beaches, granite outcrops and coastal heath land

On completing your hike we will take on other areas of Freycinet Peninsular such as Cape Tourville or you may just like to relax back at the lodge



Overnight Freycinet Lodge - dinner inclusive

Day 6 - Depart 9.00am - Freycinet to Hobart

Depart Freycinet and make our way down the south east coast of Tasmania towards Hobart visiting places of interest, maybe Wielangta Forest Reserve or the Georgian town of Richmond, arriving in Hobart in the mid afternoon and checking into your accommodation at the Henry Jones situated on Hobart's stunning waterfront.
