Gourmet wilderness & Wildlife

Walk amongst Tasmania's old growth forest at Tombstone Creek Forest Reserve, experience a gourmet campfire dinner under the stars with a glass of Tasmanian wine and taste some unique bush tucker foods on offer from our bush chef and maybe take a stroll to catch a glimpse of one of the resident platypus and sit and watch as the wildlife came alive.

Enjoy a day traveling through the Tamar Valley visiting wineries from family-run producers to state-of-the-art wineries including lunch at the Strathlynn Restaurant which offers one of the finest dining experiences in Tasmania.
