

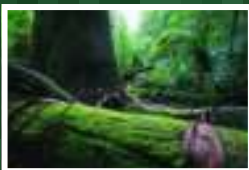
Tasmanian Nature Discovery

Quoll Patrol Combo - Option 1 (2 day & 3 night)

The Experience

Day 1—Waterfalls and wilderness with the great platypus and echidna pursuit (**Monotreme Rummage**)

Day 2—Ben Lomond National Park (optional walk) followed by a gourmet wilderness & wildlife tour (**Quoll Patrol**)



Day 1 - Waterfalls & Wilderness & Monotreme Rummage

Explore the highlands of north east Tasmania visiting Mt. Victoria Forest Reserve and the amazing single drop waterfall of Ralphs Falls. Continue on to Evercreech Forest Reserve, the home of the White Knights, the tallest white gum trees in the world. Spend the afternoon pursuing the world's only 2 monotreme species, the echidna and the platypus. Fossick around the forests and waterways to see these amazing creatures in their natural habitats to finish an amazing day of Tasmania's natural wonders.

Overnight: Beulah Heritage B&B in Scottsdale; dinner in-house

Day 2 - Ben Lomond & Quoll Patrol

Leaving Beulah after breakfast we travel to Ben Lomond, an awesome mountain of dolerite columns and scree slopes and the second highest peak in Tasmania, Legges Tor, has impressive views and a magnificent array of alpine vegetation. An optional walk to the peak is available. After a picnic lunch we stand amongst the forest giants at Tombstone Creek Forest Reserve before culminating with a gourmet campfire bush tucker dinner and wildlife spotting on private acreage. Sit and watch as the wildlife comes alive while sipping on a glass of cool climate wine.

Overnight: Beulah B&B in Scottsdale; dinner on tour
