The Experience

Tasmania's forests are marvelous, even mystical places and this tour allows us to visit some of the mountains and valleys, plains and plateaus, streams and rivers, and waterfalls that make up this diverse landscape



Ben Lomond National Park

Visit Ben Lomond with its dolerite peaks and alpine vegetation where you can continue up the mountain for its panoramic photo opportunities. You can take to opportunity to climb to the second highest point in Tasmania with a 1 hour loop walk to the summit of Legges Tor at 1572m.

Evercreech Forest Reserve

Situated in the Fingal Forests our lunch destination is the Evercreech Forest Reserve. This is home of the famous "White Knights", the tallest white gum trees in the world standing at around 91 metres. A 20 minute loop walk takes you past the tall trees and through some of natures marvels. Also on offer, time permitting is the 45 minute return walk to the small but picturesque Evercreech Falls.



The Bush Tucker Lunch

Lunch will be cooked and served at Evercreech and will include a Tasmanian cheese platter, 3 spice trout, mountain burgers in pickle-berry sauce and all accompanied by a selection of Tasmanian beverages.

Mathinna Falls

Mathinna falls is a 4 tier waterfall which cascades over a total drop of about 80 metres—a truly spectacular sight. An easy 30 minute return walk leads to the base of the falls, you will hear the falls long before you see it.



Tombstone Creek Forest Reserve

A forest of magnificent old growth forest with its giant Mountain Ash, this particular species of eucalyptus are the tallest flowering plants in the world, stand guard over numerous other mixed forest species.
