## Day 1 - Mt. William NP & Bay of Fires, Platypus and Echidnas

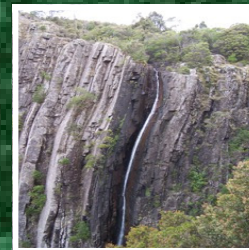
Departing Scottsdale we travel to the far north east corner of Tasmania to Mt. William National Park. Take a stroll on the stunning Bay of Fires beaches and see the resident wildlife in the area, the eastern grey kangaroo and wombat are just a couple of the inhabitants. Spend the afternoon pursuing the world's only 2 monotreme species, the echidna and the platypus. Fossick around the forests and waterways to see these amazing creatures in their natural habitats to finish an amazing day of Tasmania's natural wonders.

## Day 2 - Waterfalls & Wilderness

Explore the highlands of north east Tasmania visiting Mt. Victoria Forest Reserve and the amazing single drop waterfall of Ralphs Falls and take the 1 hour loop walk through tall melaleuca and mossy banks, passing Cash's Gorge Lookout and through button grass plains. See Columbia Falls at Pyengana before continuing on to Evercreech Forest Reserve, the home of the "White Knights," the tallest white gum trees in the world. A 20 minute loop walk takes you past the Knights and through a forest of giant ferns.
